To that end, I downloaded the <a href="#">manufacturer's drivers</a> as rpm, extracted via <i>rpmextract.sh</i> and copied the driver files to the respective root directories (etc, lib, usr). Thereafter, I installed sane 1.0.24. Upon plugging in the scanner, it is not recognized by <i>sane</i>.</p> <pre>lsusb   grep Brother Bus 001 Device 004: ID 04f9:60e0 Brother Industries, Ltd sudo sane-find-scanner\ # ... # No USB scanners found.
